Cycle Right Lessons for 5th Class:

Cost is €10 per participant - The programme is heavily subsidised by Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport, the Road Safety Authority, Cork County Council, Cork City Council and the HSE Health Promotion Department and will cost just 10 euro per child, which we kindly ask to be paid by 14th January. 5th Class pupils may wear their tracksuits on Wednesdays for the duration of the training.
