#### **School Self-Evaluation:**

A detailed flyer/note will be sent out in the coming weeks outlining a number of literacy initiatives (new and ongoing) that are being implemented in the school. A large quantity of graded reading books (for the Literacy Lift-off reading scheme) have been purchased recently. This reading programme will begin in 2nd and 3rd class.


started very well scoring 2 goals early in the game. We got into the match and scored 2 goals to
